



Gaming Perfection — Miestro Home Integration, Memphis, Tenn.

► This room happens to be the client's childhood bedroom and be wanted to convert it into a media room so that he could enjoy playing video games and watching a ton of sports. It was also going to serve as a temporary solution, almost a dry run for Miestro, as the client wanted technology that could expand into soon-to-be-built "forever home." notes Miestro's Lamar Gibson.

► There's a very large bay window that looked over the sunroom below, windows on the opposing side and several entry doors to bathrooms and closets on the other walls. Miestro designed the room so the windows would be removed and installed a 110-inch Digital Projection direct-lit LED video wall in their place.





- ► During the renovation Miestro added support systems for the video wall, relocated lighting and created a riser for an additional row of seating. Custom engravings and programming allow the client to launch any number of media with the press of a single button on the Control4 interface.
- ► Quad-viewing processing enables the client to watch multiple sports at once. The custom-designed Steinway Lyngdorf audio system is a Dolby 5.2 layout that will be able to grow into a full Dolby Atmos 7.4.4 in the future simply by adding more speakers.

Memphis Blues (Not So Much) - Miestro Home Integration, Memphis, Tenn.



- ► This theater was a year-long build process due to restricted work areas and magnitude of technology integration and trim work. Creating a soundproof room was the starting point, says Miestro's Lamar Gibson, and the integrator designed it using Kinetics products so the theater "floats" off of the floor, walls and ceiling to create a truly soundproof environment decoupled from the rest of the building.
- ► A reference-level Pro Audio Technology Dolby Atmos 11.4.6 sound system with over 8,000 watts of power provides an immersive 3D audio experience for the customer. The video system incorporates a Stewart Filmscreen Director's Choice 2.0, 14-foot-wide, 4-way masking screen system with StudioTek 100 acoustically transparent material. This screen is paired with the Wolf Cinema THX-5000 4K laser projector and sources including a Kaleidescape Strato server.





► Miestro brought in Lindsev Black from Lindsey Black Interiors to help get the right colors and trim design. The entry door with its solid soundproof core and soft velvet surface. "it's a real treat to see and feel as you enter the space. The glass window port in the door was just the right touch for that classic movie look and feel," Gibson says.
